Using a fraction of the components needed for a comparable tube and fittings structure, Haki platforms are as durable and versatile as they are quick and economical to erect, achieving high loads and coping easily with various lift heights.

UKSSH's expertise in Public Access Staircases, combined with their experience in supplying public viewing platforms, also meant that Portway Scaffolding had total confidence that the stand was fully compliant with all legal safety requirements.
